

## 2019-20

- **On 7.4.2019** we organized FACE to FACE meeting of differently abled persons at Kanchipuram and about 50 differently abled persons participated who has been given awareness on various facilities, concessions and projects of Tamil Nadu Govt, and Central Govt for the welfare of differently abled.
- **During June 2019**, we conducted training camp for differently abled in Boccia games 20 differently abled persons participated and received training.
- **During Aug 2019**, we have taken 250 differently abled persons from Chennai to Kanchipuram in 5 buses to have dharshan of AthiVaradhar (the DEITY was taken out from Pushkarani Tank in the temple once in 40 years and dharshan was made available for 48 days) and temple was made disabled friendly with ramps, special vehicles, wheel chairs etc and visit and special dharshan for differently abled was organized by us in co-ordination with District Collector & District Superintendent of Police.
- **During Oct 2019**, we conducted multi specialty medical camp with the support of various hospitals in Chennai city and senior Doctors & Surgeons participated and conducted the test and more than 250 differently abled persons benefitted from the camp.
- **During Nov 2019**, we donated Rs. 50000/- to a physically challenged sports women to participate in Paralympic Sports for getting training in athletics.
- **On 3.12.2019**, being the International Day of differently abled, we met His Excellency Dr. Banvarilal Prohit the Governor of Tamil Nadu at Raj Bhavan and presented memorandum regarding various demands for differently abled and the Governor was cordial with us during our meet & blessed all the differently abled in the State on the occasion of the International Day of Differently Abled.
- **On 22.12.2019**. We and another NGO jointly organized “Reach the Beach” program and about 100 differently abled persons participated and we took them to the Besant Nagar Beach in wheel chairs and gave them opportunity to enjoy the waves and waters touching their feet by laying special paths on the beach sand to take the wheel chairs on the sand.
- **March 2020 – On 6<sup>th</sup>& 7<sup>th</sup> March 2020 we conducted NATIONAL GAMES FOR DIFFERENTLY ABLED at YMCA Grounds, Nandanam, Chennai**
