

April 2026

- On 18.04.2026, the Tamil Nadu Udavikkaram Association for the Welfare of Differently Abled and Iyarkai Thaayagam jointly organized an Election Awareness Program for Persons with Disabilities at the M.G.R.–Janaki School, Saligramam, Chennai.
- On 24 March 2026 at Salem District: The Department for the Welfare of Persons with Disabilities organized a 100% voter participation awareness rally in connection with the upcoming Legislative Assembly elections. The rally was flagged off by Salem District Collector Mrs. R. Brinda Devi, I.A.S. In this event, under the leadership of Dr. AthiAnna, who serves as the Salem District President and Deputy President of the Federation, more than 100 persons with disabilities of various categories participated. Participants took part in the rally using three-wheeler petrol scooters and battery-operated wheelchairs, demonstrating and promoting awareness about the importance of voting in the forthcoming elections.
- The Rotary Club of Salem Midtown, in association with Sambandam Spinning Mill and the Salem District Udavikkaram Welfare Association for Persons with Disabilities, distributed artificial limbs to 120 beneficiaries who had lost their legs due to accidents or diabetes. The distribution was held at the Salem Palaniyandi Memorial Hospital. For the past 36 years, the Chennai-based organization Mukti has been providing artificial limbs. The organization takes individual measurements for each beneficiary and custom-makes the artificial limbs according to their needs.
